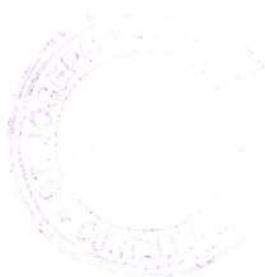
R-Day celebrations at Cortalim

VASCO: The Chicalim Youth Farmers Club (CYFC) collaborated with Chicalim Parish Youth for the 'Plantation Drive 2.0' with the theme "Zhadd Roi Jivit Fuloi" on August 15. The event aimed to develop a conservationist approach towards building a better environment among the younger generation. "As we are in the lockdown mode, supported by St Joseph Vaz College, Cortalim, and Goa State Biodiversity Board, who provided us with saplings, we took up the initiative. Bolmax Pereira has encouraged all youth of Goa to take up agriculture as youth activity. "Initially, there might be a few people to start up, but these very few people will be looked upon by the future generation," said Fr Pereira.
